## Velas™. Fascinating minimalism.

We designed this exceptionally slender and appealing chair especially for informal occasions. For those places where a comfortable, relaxed, but professional atmosphere is required. Velas lets you sit at ease, but be ready to respond at the same time.

The design theme is based on steel tube, a material used since the era of classical modernism. Popular since the 1960s, the principle of a supporting metal frame structure with upholstered seats and backrests is interpreted in a distinctive design. The elegant foot section becomes a fluid transition of front legs, side sections and rear horizontal brace, creating an especially informal, but purposeful look.

The aluminium and steel foot section is either bright chromium-plated or powder coated. The fabric covers are available in different colours. The subtle, pure, streamlined shape, combined with the light, extremely compact upholstery lend the chair a soft look. Or to put it in Eric Degenhardt, the designer's words: "The chair suggests rest and relaxation." The optional foot stool just enhances this sentiment. The side table is a perfect complement to the range.



Whether you're in a pensive mood, reading the latest bestseller or just want to while away the time of day: Velas™ is simply a comfortable and enjoyable place to sit and an integral part of an office, lounge or hotel lobby. Combined with a footstool and matching side table, the chair becomes a place to chill.

## Special details.

The seat covers are made from an innovative, three-dimensional fabric which is tauter at the bottom and more elastic at the top of the backrest, making Velas pleasant to sit on.

The special technique for manufacturing the covers creates the distinctive surface structure and the lining lends the chair a soft appeal. The knitted covers are seamless, pulled over the frame like a sleeve and zip fastened. As a result, when the covers wear out, you can simply renew them.

High-quality materials are also used in the rest of the furniture. The foot stool is upholstered with very durable leather, the surface is appropriately shaped and inclines towards the chair. The side tables are crafted with select real wood veneers.

### Function

Relaxation chair, complemented with a footstool and side table, suitable for a lounge, lobby, or reception area, in informal meeting environments and in residential settings.

### Frame

Frame combines sections in die-cast aluminium, with stretcher and front legs in steel tube, bright chromium-plated or coated in the colours black or white.  
Frame tensioned by bracket in curved, low-profile steel coated to match the black or white coated frame or in silver satin finish in the case of a bright chromium-plated frame. The standard version for carpeted floors is with glides at the front; optionally available with additional glides at the rear for hard or soft floors, on request with felt insert.

### Seat and back

Unitary seat and back frames made of flat oval steel tube, upholstered with a two-ply seamless cover, manufactured from extremely strong polyester fabric using 3-D knitting methods. Cover lined with cut foam.

### Foot stool


Butt leather cover in dark brown and black, plywood core material.  
Die-cast aluminium frame, stool legs made of solid steel, obtainable either bright chromium-plated, or coated in black or white. Standard glides for carpets, or optionally with felt inserts.

### Side table

Veneer surface in natural ash, natural oak or walnut, multiplex core material.  
Frame: steel flange, coated in black or white, solid steel table legs, obtainable bright chromium-plated, or coated in black or white. Standard glides for carpets, or optionally with felt inserts.

### Standards

Velas lounge chair: DIN EN 13761 and DIN EN 1022 (undergoing tests; current status on request.)
